

Canterlopes Fair Rules

- 1) Canterlopes club members are expected to be positive representatives of the club at all times while on the Fairgrounds and must abide by the general Fair rules & Extension Office Fair rules.
- 2) Any registered horse club member may show in the horse Showmanship and Gymkhana competitions.
- 3) In order to show in the Gambler's Choice competition a 4-Her must have registered their project horse with the Extension Office by May 1 of the current 4-H year. Only in extreme circumstances and with permission from the 4-H leaders may a 4-Her show an animal that is NOT their declared project animal. Additionally, General Fair & Extension Office rules apply to the Gambler's Choice competition, as this competition is treated as the Canterlopes' "show" at the fair. (This means that 4-Hers must complete and turn in a project book the previous 4-H year, be a registered member by Dec. 31, complete a fair qualifier activity, and attend the mandatory fair meeting and cleanup, as well as any other requirements given by the fair and extension.)
- 4) In order to show in the Gambler's Choice competition as an alumnus, the individual must be an alumnus of ANY 4-H club from any part of the United States or abroad. Please contact Jackie McClintic (brio16@aol.com) for more information.
