

Dairy Club Rules 2017

1. To show at the Loudoun County Fair, exhibitor must be a registered member of the Loudoun County Dairy Club by January 1st of the year showing.
2. The member must be an active member and in good standing with the club.
3. Members that own animals must have the transfer complete and be in ownership by May 1st of the current year.
4. Classes for conformation:
 - Spring Heifer Calf (03-01-17 to 5-31-17)
 - Winter Heifer Calf (12-01-17 to 2-29-17)
 - Fall Heifer Calf (09-01-16) to 11-30-16)
 - Summer Yearling Heifer (06-01-16 to 08-31-16)
 - Spring Yearling (03-01-16 to 05-31-16)
 - Winter Yearling (12-01-15 to 2-28-15)
 - Fall Yearling (09-01-15 to 11-30-15)
5. Animals will be free of contagious diseases (ringworm, warts) and be vaccinated for shipping fever within 30 days of the show. All calves over 5 months of age will be vaccinated against brucellosis.
6. The Purebred Dairy Cattle Association Unified Scorecard for Dairy Showmanship will be adhered to. (Adopted May 2003)
7. The Purebred Dairy Cattle Show Ring Code of Ethics will be adhered to. (Adopted April 3, 2004)
