

In addition to all Club Rules, the Extension Office requires all 4-H members do the following in order to show at the Loudoun County Fair:

1. All members must complete a project book for each club they are currently enrolled in in order to show at the following year's Fair. If the 4-Her does not show at the Fair, a project book must still be submitted in order to qualify the following year. Completed record books must be turned in to the Extension Office by 5:00PM on Friday, October 13th and receive a 75% minimum score (red ribbon).
2. All members must complete one Fair Qualifier prior to July 10th of the Fair year. Some Fair Qualifiers are:
 - a. Joshua's Hands Fall Festival – October 8th
 - b. Waterford Fair – October 8th & 9th
 - c. Officer Training – November 3rd
 - d. 4-H Day at the Capitol – January 24th
 - e. Presentation Day & Table Setting Contest – February 22nd
 - f. Share The Fun & Fashion Revue – March 11th
 - g. 4-H Congress – June 19th – 22nd
 - h. 4-H Camp (Camper or Counselor) – June 18th – 22nd
 - i. 4th of July Parade: Float Building or Planning and Parade Participation
 - j. Any others identified and approved by the Extension Office
3. Attend one of the mandatory Fair Cleanup dates in July.
4. Cloverbud members must complete the above requirements, with the exception of the project book.
