10	Neatness/Presentation – Your project book should be neat and clean, typed or hand written in pen. All of the pages should be free from dirt or corrections and in the proper order. All photos should be securely and neatly fixed.	_____
10	Completeness – All of the pages in the Project Book handout should be printed out and completed in your project book. Any pages that do not apply to your project should still be included, with a “N/A” written on the page. All signatures should be collected.	_____
